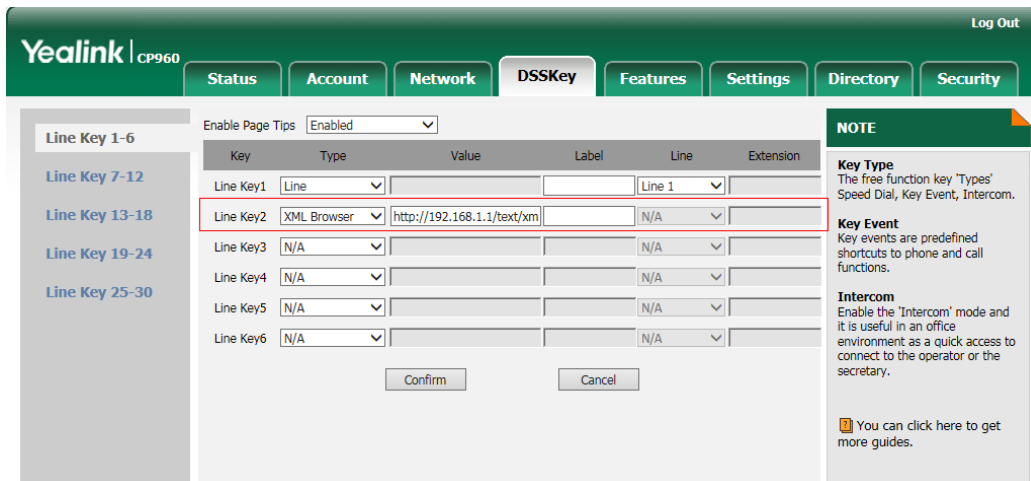

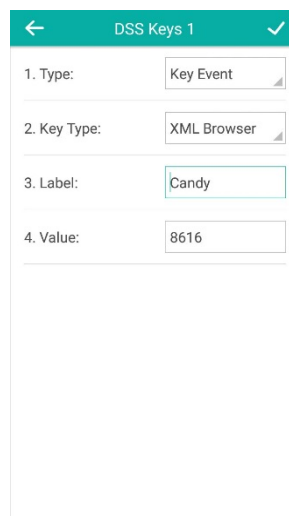
To configure an XML Browser key via web user interface:
