





Export the files


There are only 5 steps you need to do:



Export the files

Step 1


- Login the phone web UI and input the username and password which are both **admin** by default



Export the files

Step 2


- Click on Settings->Configuration.
- Set Log Level to 6
- Click 'Confirm' ,then restart the phone



Export the files

Step 3

- Click 'Start' to capture the Trace
- **reproduce your issue**
- Click 'Stop' to stop capturing.
- Click 'Export' to export PCAP , and then save the file to your local system.

Step 4

- Export config.bin
